Scholarships, fee remission, textbook assistance and travel subsidy

- 1. Any students who achieved good results in the final term exams may receive a scholarship in the new school year as granted by the school. (Tuition fees are free for the first place and half for the second and third places.)
- 2. Students who have achieved outstanding results in the Secondary 1 to 6 will receive the Cheung Kwun Shing Memorial Scholarship as encouragement.
 - (a) "Academic Achievement Award": A total of six students who rank first at all grades will be awarded scholarships of \$2000 each.
 - (b) "Academic Leap Award": Six students who make the greatest overall improvement will be awarded scholarships of \$1000 each.
 - (c) "Best Performance in DSE": The student with the highest score in the public examination will be awarded a scholarship of \$2000.
- The second and third place in the Secondary 1 to 6 will receive a scholarship of \$300 and \$200 respectively.
- 4. The first place in individual subjects in Secondary 1 to 6 will receive a scholarship of \$200.
- 5. Annual School Fee:
 - S1 S3 \$3000 (Paid in 10 installments)
 - S4 S5 \$3200 (Paid in 10 installments)
 - S6 \$3200 (Paid in 6 installments)
- 6. All fee remission applications will be processed at the beginning of September. The fee remission are assessed in accordance with the scoring criteria established by the Student Finance office. Successful applicants may receive full remission or half remission. Students who are under the Comprehensive Social Security Assistance (CSSA) Scheme or are granted full level of assistance under the student financial assistance schemes provided by the Student Finance Office do NOT need to pay the tuition fee.
- 7. Students in Secondary 1 to 6 can apply for book textbook assistance and travel subsidy from the Government.
