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惠僑是以「全人教育」為宗旨·期望學生在惠僑成長的日子·能夠發掘潛能·認識自身的「獨一無二」·從而構建積極正面的生活態度·身心均得到全面的發展。因此·我們在正規的課程以外提供多元化的課外活動·如舉辦全方位學習、歷奇訓練營及領袖訓練課程等·以豐富學生的學習經歷。而「世界學堂計劃」·更是惠僑課外活動計劃的重點。是項計劃早於2001年惠僑已配合教育改革建議開展·冀盼學生能超越學科課程和考試的局限·擴闊眼界·體驗與別不同的學習經歷。

我相信,走出課室、跨越地域這種學習方式,不但可讓學生了解不同地方的歷史文化,認識不同地域的風土人情,通過親身的體驗,他們更學會進一步思考自己在社會、國家的角色和定位。此外,在這離家十數天的旅程中,學生需要在外地與同學共處、互相照顧,從中亦學會理解他人、尊重別人,使其個人社交能力得以提升,他日更能愉快地融入社會。

本校期望每位同學在學期間·最少有一次往海外考察的機會·以達到「立足香港·放眼世界」的辦學宗旨。本校師生已先後到訪北京、上海、南京、四川、廣州、長江三峽、昆明、麗江、珠江三角洲、惠州及澳門等地·同學反應熱烈·指受益不淺。

過往幾年,我們曾多次拜訪及參觀內地的學校,例如北京市第七中學、北京市第六十五中學、廣州黃埔軍校、南京市第廿九中學、南京市金陵中學、南京體育學院、四川市洛帶中學等,一方面同學都結交了不少新朋友,另方面院校之間亦建立了親密友好的關係。其中,我校分別與南京市第廿九中學、昆明八中、北京六一中學、廣州天河中學、北京首都師範大學第二附屬中學結為姊妹學校,雙方就教育現狀、學校管理、兩地教育體制、課程內容、教學方法及

經驗等各方面不時進行學習交流;並通過體育夏令營、作品交流、書信往來等方式,增進學生之間的了解、交流和友誼,更派出優秀教師駐校,擔任短期教學顧問等。種種安排,均有助進一步推動中港兩地中學的互動交流,共同提升辦學質素。

與國內友校聯繫只是一個起點,我們期望與香港以外的地方建立聯繫,藉此令惠僑於社區發展的成果能澤及遠方。去年本校首次衝出神州大地,資助學生到英國牛津大學,得到本校顧問 — 牛津大學劉偉榮博士親身教授英語及科學知識,學生均稱獲益甚豐。在未來的日子,我們當竭盡所能,籌辦更多更具代表性的歷史文化之旅,讓同學成為不折不扣的世界公民。

扼要言之,「世界學堂計劃」的目標包括:

- 1. 發揚本校培養學生立足香港·放眼世界的辦學宗旨;
- 2. 使學生接觸不同文化及歷史,增廣見聞、溫故知新;
- 3. 使學生透過親身體驗,瞭解並比較不同地域的風土人情;
- 4. 使學生領略世界各地不同生活方式;及
- 5. 使學生嘗試獨立觀察,加強個人洞察能力。

面對課程改革的轉變,上課模式從課堂教學到全方位、跨科學習。「世界學堂計劃」就是 貫徹以「學生為本」的精神,藉以建立學生各種自學能力,將被動的學習型態轉化為主動的考 察和探求,通過思考和組織、與人協作等方式,將不同的學科知識融匯貫通,並建立終身學習 的學習態度。

世界學堂計劃:立足香港 放眼世界

九七回歸後,不少學校都舉辦形形式式的學術交流活動,地點從鄰近的廣州到遙遠的首都 北京,由於費用不菲,加上籌備需時,因此,不少學校望而卻步。即使僥倖成團,也只能讓極 少數學生參加。有見及此,惠僑英文中學不惜花費龐大的人力物力,籌設「世界學堂計劃」,而北京之行,只是本校的首個目標而已。我們計劃到世界各地,以發揚本校「立足香港、放眼世界」的辦學宗旨。

學生家長齊參與——世界學堂籌款晚會

為了讓更多學生參加此項甚具意義的交流活動·本校由學生會及家長教師會發起「世界學堂籌款晚會」·籌得四萬多元·用以資助學生·尤其是家境清貧及負責表演的學生。從教師到學生都傾力演出·除師生表演籌款和賣物會外·小食部也鼎力支持·參與義賣·連副校長、校工都不惜粉墨登場·務求籌得更多善款。

為免影響學生的正常課堂教學·惠僑英文中學「北京學術文化交流團」選擇在二零零一年三月人口普查假期進行·團員共四十三人·當中包括學生、教師和家長·充分體現家校合作的精神·也提供了一個親子活動的良機。由三月十五日至二十日·一連六天·除到訪北京重點中學、進行兩地學校交流會外·也順道遊覽當地名勝。

京港學術交流 樂也融融

為達到京港兩地學術交流的目的·本校造訪了北京兩所重點中學——「北京七中」和「北京六十五中」。

「北京七中」安排學生坐在惠僑中學師生的兩旁,會後由學生贈送紀念品,更安排兩地師生在偌大的學生飯堂坐下,喝一喝地道飲料,品嚐精美點心,在輕鬆愉快的氣氛中交流彼此的學習心得。該校的課外活動計有合唱團、舞蹈團、天文組、航模組等。

期間·北京七中的陸逸民校長帶領惠僑師生參觀校舍·不獨設備完善的室內運動場令人眼前一亮·標準的大型戶外足球場亦為同學創造了充滿陽光空氣的活動空間·更為學校帶來了額外可觀的收入——在假日及課餘·校方將球場出租·所得收入·全部用於學生身上·足以令的辦學資源更為充裕。

由於時間緊逼,北京第七中學未能安排惠僑師生觀課,但從學生在課外活動方面的出色表現,可以推想學生在學習上的認真專注和投入程度。像黎穎同學,天天拿王菲的粵語歌曲一句一句地跟著錄影帶學廣東話,卻字正腔圓,表現毫不遜色。看來,該校學生處事態度、學習的毅力和精神,以及個人的自律性和自覺性都很值得香港學生學習。



北京六十五中-素質教育的典範

北京自一九九七年起實施「素質教育」·作為北京市的重點中學·北京六十五中李輅校長表示:「學校無論在設施、師資訓練和教學質量方面都有所改善·例如增設實驗室、計算機房、舞蹈室、演播室及全校閉路電視系統等·電腦也增至二百台·以配合資訊科技的高速發展。」

六十五中建於一九五五年‧前身是一八六四年成立的育英學校‧一九五五年高中部獨立設校‧成立北京市當時唯一一所純高級中學。現時有五十個教學班‧共二千三百名學生‧有三幢教學樓‧建築面積達二萬六千平方米‧校園佔地一萬三千八百平方米。

惠僑老師表示:「演播室是最令我印象難忘的,它是『銀杏電視台』的錄影廠,學生可以獨立製作錄影帶並播放,通過設在全校課室及特別室的閉路電視向全校學生作現場直播、具現場感和真實感,藉以發揮更大的宣傳果效。此外,該校為兼顧學生的全面發展,逢星期二及星期五下午兩堂課均為學生安排了課外活動訓練,而合唱團、藝術團及舞蹈團的活動及訓練則安排於星期六進行,學生的課外活動多姿多采,而且已經納入正規課程之中了。」其實,除多次在藝術節、合唱節上獲一二等獎外,在二零零零年市教委命名學校舞蹈團為市金帆藝術團第五分團。該校學生允文允武,據李校長表示,該校的初中足球隊更是全市的冠軍隊伍,曾獲獎無數,堪作楷模。

對於教師的支援方面,該校特設教師電子閱覽室,大批電腦供教師備課之用。而作為一所高標準配備學校,六十五中有教職工二百一十五人,專任教師中、中級和高級教師佔百份之八十,其中有百份之二十五已達到研究生水平。

該校學生參加課外活動十分積極投入,卻沒有影響到學生的成績,該校百分之一百的學生能 考入理想的大學就是鐵証。

此外·六十五中是北京市對外開放學校·與日、美、英、澳、瑞典等多個國家的教育工作者 建立了廣泛的聯繫。李校長表示:「學校幹部、師生外出學習考察活動日漸頻繁·眾多的外事活 動又促進了學校內部的發展。」

未來計劃:開拓國際視野

「北京學術文化交流團」除了與當地學校交流外·也安排了一連串的參觀活動。從街頭美食到帝王御膳;從城內的紫禁城、天安門、王府井、東安市場·到城外的長城、蘆溝橋和明十三陵;期間·突破了教室的局限·師生打破了溝通上的隔膜·濟濟一堂;同學經過數天的共處·飲食起居·也築起了更深厚的友誼。讀萬卷書·行萬里路·豈是短短三言兩語所能道盡?對北京·對偌大的黃土地——中華民族的母親·土生土長的香港惠僑師生·仍然充滿無限憧憬!

「學習不應局限在書本中,也不應囿於課室內。應鼓勵學生親身體驗不同民族的特色,領略世界各地的風俗文化。」以配合前香港行政長官董建華先生對教育的目標和期望:「要讓青年學生認識我國的歷史,接觸我國博大精深的文化傳統;同時要讓他們開拓國際視野,懂得吸收外國文化的優秀成果。」本校將繼續努力耕耘,切切實實地朝著既定的目標邁進。

2001 24/12-30/12 南京上海學術文化交流團

這次「世界學堂計劃」的旗幟飄揚在歷史悠久,集繁榮古雅於一體的華東地區,包括南京、上海、蘇州、揚州和 無錫等城市,交流團拜訪了全國重點中學——南京金陵中學,亦參觀了奧運冠軍搖籃——南京體育學院,學校籃球隊 更與南京第九中學進行一場激烈的友誼賽。

繁華的十里洋場

寶貴的歷史課

到訪侵華日軍南京大屠殺紀念館,可算 是行程中最富教化意義,也最觸人心弦的環 節・當導遊介紹廣場上一些鵝卵石和雕塑的象 徵意義時,同學尚未有多大反應,直到看見大 批遇難同胞的骸骨,所有人的眼神瞬間黯淡下 來,目光久久地盯著一具被扭曲了的嬰兒屍 骨。在一幅幅記載日軍暴行的照片前,不少同 學的眼睛紅了,整個展覽廳靜悄悄的,只偶然

參觀完畢,大家一直戚然不語。良久, 有位低年級男生吁了一口氣,說:「將來有了 孩子,一定要带他們來看看,而且不只看一 次,而是要看五十次、一百次,這是最真實的 歷史,是不容竄改的事實。」

「萬頃波光歸稼穑‧四山靈氣慄蛟龍」‧三王廟內‧供奉了治水功臣李冰父子‧今天‧在安瀾橋上一步一驚心‧「深淘灘、低作堰」‧令人嘆服古人的睿智和膽識。走在見底的石灘‧仰望山上‧幾疑神仙就棲於煙靄繚繞處。「三星堆」出土文物幾乎改寫以中原文化為中心的歷史‧眼前的塑像‧精巧得近乎完美‧足與西周的鐘鼎文明分庭抗禮‧「是外星人建造的嗎?」同學爭相買一個仿製品回去收藏‧大家都上了難得的歷史課。

在成都·我們與成都市洛帶中學校作課程交流·獻課教師包括曹順祥(中文)、王萍萍(語文)、林秀英(歷史)、張春(英語)、黃睿(信息技術)、黃娟(物理)·曹主任用普通話教授杜甫詩——《登高》·對杜甫詩作新角度的解讀和 詮釋·同學積極投入。課後·洛帶中學和惠僑師生紛紛集體拍照和留念·後來·在參觀江西會館和廣東會館時·同學們已經手牽手談天說地了·他們都說:「很珍惜這份難得的友誼·回港後仍可用電郵保持聯絡呢!」

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感想 Dr. Wing Lau, Head of Design Physics Department, Oxford University A visit with a purpose

It was probably one of the longest drives I had for ages, not because Oxford is millions of miles away from the London airport, but because I was late in setting off to pick up my visitors, Mr. Lam and his 4 students who were coming to stay with us for a fortnight. At 6 O'clock in the morning, there was hardly any traffic on the motorway. But that didn't help. I knew I would be late for their arrival. The occasional yawns reminded me that I should have been in bed instead of driving down that motorway. But I drove on regardless. I had not slept much the night before. We received a warning from the council that Oxford was about to experience one of the severest flooding for decades and all the houses along the riverbanks had to get prepared for the eventuality. Sand bags were delivered and piled up during the night to stop water sipping through to the house. Our house was no exception as it backs onto one of the many rivers that make Oxford so picturesque. We had worked through the night to make sure that should this happen to our house the safety of our quests would not be impaired.

As I approached the airport pick-up area, they were already there waiting for me. How embarrassing! I should be the one to greet them on their arrival, but instead I was greeted! It was a warm morning, albeit a little windy. This was what I call a fine British summer morning and I was in my shorts and T-shirt. But my guests had a different reception to the weather - they thought it was too cold for a summer. What they didn't realize was that it was the best weather they had for the whole of their stay.

The journey to Oxford was scenic, enjoyable and exciting – I could tell from their facial expression when they saw sheep, in their hundreds, grazing and wandering leisurely by the hillside. Although the driving took nearly an hour, none of them felt tired even though they had just endured a 13-hour flight journey. As soon as they arrived at my house, they begged to be taken to explore the city. The city center is less than 10 minutes walk from my house. At 9:30 in the morning, it was already packed with tourists. We walked a bit and visited one of the colleges before jetlag finally hit them. We went back to the house and spent the afternoon relaxing in my garden, watching the water level rising and speculating what could happen if the river really burst its bank. It didn't at the end and the water level subsided. Some were seemingly disappointed.

For the next 12 days, the students followed a tight programme that combined studying and working with sightseeing, with, perhaps, more emphasis on studying. Summary accounts of what they did during their stay are being reported elsewhere in this magazine by the individual students, and I am sure they provide fascinating readings. I believe all the students enjoyed their stay and I would like to thank Mr. Lam for doing an admirable job in supervising them.

It is of course wrong for me to give the impression that the 4 students can now speak fluent English as a result of taking part in this trip. That takes time and requires regular practice. The main achievement of this trip was, in my opinion, the ability to break the barrier

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of their reluctance to speak English in public. Once that barrier is broken, speaking English is as easy as breathing in air.

Could you imagine what life is like living in a place with no gas or electricity supply, like how our great grand parents lived decades ago? Well, our student witnessed it. This happened when a colleague of mine, Mike, who runs a farm, learned of their visit and agreed to invite them to his farmhouse for one day. There they saw how Mike and his family grow their own vegetables, raise their own poultry and other farm animals for their daily meat consumption and chop woods for their heating needs etc. Although Mike works for the university and could well afford a life many times more luxurious than the one he and his family choose to live, they do so because they enjoy being independent and being able to build things with their own bare hands. This contrasts sharply with the city life that our students live. When resources come too easy, you would not know how to treasure them and as a consequence they are turned into unnecessary garbage. Such life style does endless harm to our environment and wastes our natural resources. Mike believes that the true value of living is the ability to leave behind a world that our grand children can live without any fear of it being destroyed by pollution one day. He is absolutely right on this!

During their stay, our guests had visited a number of Oxford colleges, large and small. The one they all seemed to enjoy most was no doubt the Christ Church College. The grand architecture of the college building, its magnificent front quad, the imposing Cathedral and most of all the dining hall made famous by various films have left them with the impression that a place in that college must be the ultimate goal for any would be A-level student. While no visitors are allowed to go inside the college dormitory, our students had the rare opportunity to visit one in the one and only one women's college in Oxford - St. Hilda's College. They were taken there by one of my students, Elizabeth Mills, who graduated in this summer and now works for me. Elizabeth was a St. Hilda's girl. She spent three days coaching them mainly conversational English with role-plays in the college quad. She even taught them how to bake cakes in the dormitory kitchen!

No Oxford visit is complete without also taking a trip to Cambridge. The two universities are seen by the outside world to be competing fiercely to occupy the top place in the university league table, and as such we do have many things in common; from the collegiate and tutorial system to the architectural style of the college buildings. So, off we went one Sunday. The weather was exceptionally good and while a few of us preferred a quiet picnic by the riverbank, Mr. Lam decided to venture punting with the students. I was quietly hoping that he would spend the whole afternoon spinning around in his punt and going nowhere. But he did well! After lunch, we went to a soap factory. We saw piles of different kinds of soap. Some were in bottles and some looked like cartoon characters. They were all very pretty. We were shown how the soap was made. First, the raw materials were stored in a large storage tank. Then they were mixed together in another enormous tank. After that, the soaps were wrapped and packed into bundles. We also learned how they designed their soap. The people were really working hard and they all truly focused on their job. Some were diligently testing the products to see if they were safe to use. The factory was really grand. The machines there were gigantic and the whole factory smelled really pleasant!

The next factory we visited produced clothes. There were five floors. There were different departments on each floor. We started

our tour of the factory from the top floor and ended our tour on the bottom floor. The top floor was fully automated. There were vast amounts of machines making parts of clothes. They were really fast and efficient. Before the visit, I thought they would be noisy but it turned out that the machines were really silent. Everyone was amazed! There were also lots of machines on the fourth floor. There were workers for sewing the various parts of clothes together. Some other workers were using them to make parts of clothes just like the ones upstairs, but the ones they made were far more complex. Humans are really better than machines! Handmade products are really more worthy!

Workers on the third floor were responsible for classification and checking the quality of the clothes. There were plastic cylinders and the clothes were stretched over them so that they could be examined. Some needed to be washed and some needed to be corrected. After the quality check, the workers on the second floor put various final decorations onto the clothes. Fancy buttons and elegant pockets were being sewed onto the clothes. Frills, laces and other assorted accessories were sewn onto the clothes. Eventually, they would be sent to the bottom floor. There they were being packed into boxes and labeled.

After visiting the two factories, we had a small Q&A session with some of their administrative officers. They talked about the future plans of their companies and what they thought about the economy of China. It was really informative. I learned about a great deal of things. After that, we went to an exquisite Chinese restaurant for dinner.




學生感想曾諾文同學
