

Application Guidelines for S1 Discretionary Places

1. **Application Period:** 2nd January to 16th January, 2020
2. **Application Procedure:**
 - i. Please submit the completed application form with the stub of S1 Discretionary Places Scheme issued by the EDB.
 - ii. The following documents should be submitted:
 - Photocopy of the H.K. Identity Card (original copy should be presented for verification.)
 - Photocopies of the academic reports of the last two years (original copies should be presented for verification)
 - Photocopies of other supporting documents or certificates
 - iii. An application fee of HK\$20 will be collected when the application is accepted for processing. The application fee is non-refundable. An official receipt will be issued to all applicants upon payment.
 - iv. Successful applicants will be notified of fees payable, date and methods of payment.
3. **Interview:**
 - i. Interview Period: 10th February to 14th March, 2020. Applicants will be notified of the date, time and venue of the interview by phone.
 - ii. Both applicants and parents are required to attend the interview.
 - iii. Applicants will be assessed according to their language ability, reasoning skills, attitude, and etiquette.

Notes for Applicants

1. All students are required to join the Voluntary Service Programme. They must complete at least FOUR voluntary service programmes, in or outside school every academic year.
2. All Secondary One students and Secondary Two students are required to enroll in one of the following uniform groups and Art courses respectively.

3. English will be used as the medium of instruction for all subjects except Chinese Language, Chinese History and Liberal Studies in all EMI classes in S1-S3.
4. For this academic year, the monthly school fee is HK\$300 for Secondary One (paid in ten installments). The school fee is used for the following purposes: tuition, air-conditioning, enrichment courses, travel arrangements for school activities, and other subsidies.
5. Impoverished students, including those from families receiving the CSSA and students receiving SFAA could apply for school fee remission.
