Secondary One Discretionary Places Application Memorandum (2023-2025)

A. Application Procedures.

1. Obtaining the Application Form:

You can obtain the application form by visiting the school administration office or download it from the school website <http://www.wkc.edu.hk/> starting from December 2, 2024.

Office Hours:

Monday to Friday (9:00 AM to 5:00 PM)

Saturday (9:00 AM to 12:30 PM)

2. Submitting the Application Form:

- (a) Submit to the school administration office during the office hours, or
- (b) Submit through the "Secondary One Allocation Electronic Platform."(eSSPA)

3. Submission Deadline: (January 16, 2025)

Applicants must submit the following documents along with the application:

- (a) The Education Bureau's "Secondary One Discretionary Places Application Form" (including the "Education Bureau stub," "School stub," and "Parent stub"; the "Parent stub" will be returned to the parent after verification).
- (b) The school's Secondary One discretionary admission application form with a photo attached.
- (c) A copy of the student's identity document (e.g., ID card, birth certificate, passport, etc.).
- (d) A copy of the student's Primary Five and Primary Six first semester report cards.
- (e) Copies of other relevant information (applicants are not required to submit a primary school recommendation letter).
- (f) Two self-addressed return envelopes (no postage required).

4. Discretionary Places Available:

The school has 36 discretionary places available for application.

5. Interviews:

The school will arrange interviews for each applicant on February 22, 2025 (Saturday). Details regarding the interview will be notified to each applicant individually.

6. Announcement of Successful Candidates:

The school will announce the list of successful candidates for Secondary One discretionary places on March 27, 2025, and will notify all successful parents in writing and by phone regarding the admission matters. Those accepted by the school must follow the registration procedures announced by the Education Bureau.

7. Admission Criteria and Weighting:

Academic achievement	(25%)	Conduct	(25%)
performance in extra-curricular activities	(25%)	Performance at interview	(25%)

8. Release of results:

Parents of successful applicants for Discretionary Places will be notified by letter and phone on 27 March 2025. (Friday). All participating students will receive the eSSPA allocation results (including results at the Discretionary Places and Central Allocation stages) on 8 July 2025 (Friday). The registration period is from July 10 to July 11, 2025.

10. Others:

- (a) English classes are taught in English for students in Form 1 to Form 3. (Subjects such as Chinese, Chinese History, Music, Visual Arts, and Physical Education are taught in Chinese. In our school, there are two classes for Chinese and two classes for English in each level from Form 1 to Form 3.
- (b) For this academic year, the monthly school fee is HK\$300 for Secondary One (paid in ten installments). The school fee is used for the following purposes: tuition, air-conditioning, enrichment courses, and travel arrangements for school activities, and other subsidies.
- iii. Impoverished students, including those from families receiving the CSSA and students receiving SFAA could apply for school fee remission.
